may be worn for most events, with the exception of all general assemblies and dinner, when long pants are required.

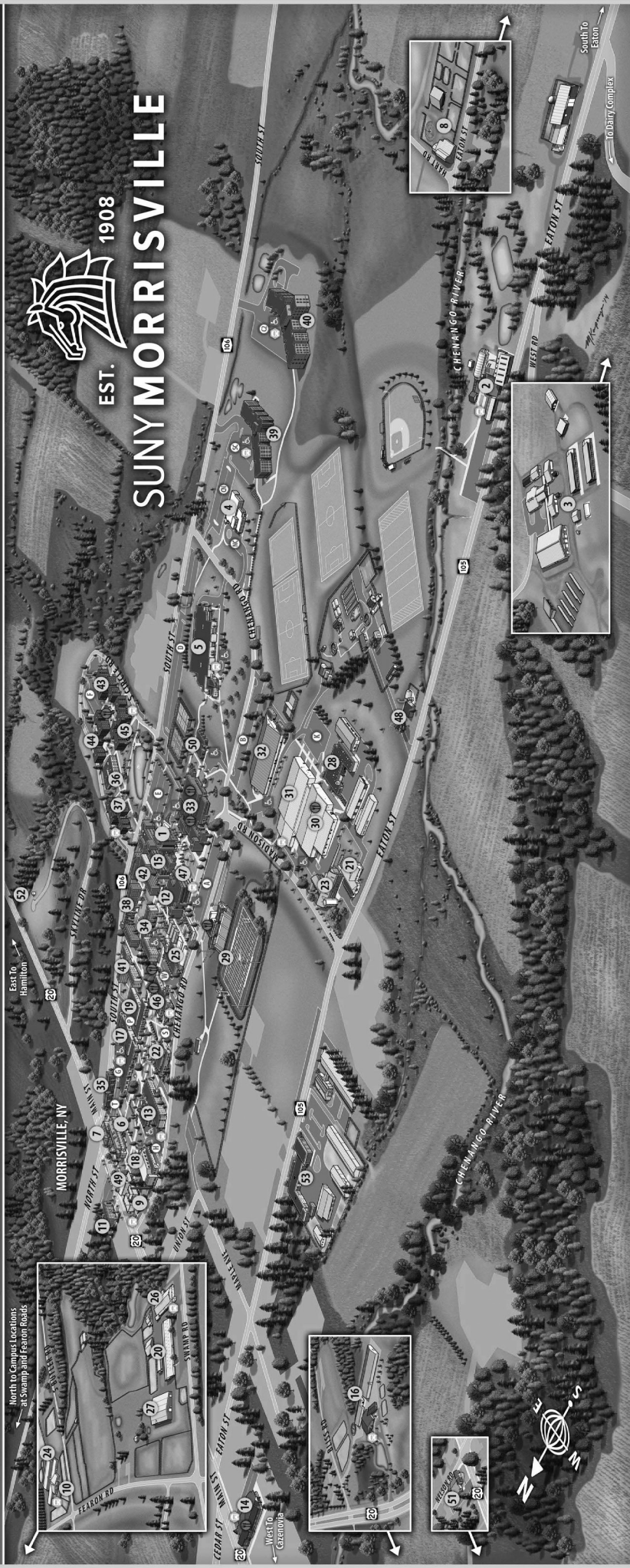
Campaign Rules
